MESSAGE NOTES | *Love in Action* | March 16, 2025 | Pastor Stan Pegram

MARK 10:35-37 = *Then James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came over and spoke to him. "Teacher," they said, "we want you to do us a favor."* ³⁶ *"What is your request?" he asked.* ³⁷ *They replied, "When you sit on your glorious throne, we want to sit in places of honor next to you, one on your right and the other on your left."*

JAMES 3:1 = *Dear brothers and sisters, not many of you should become teachers in the church, for we who teach will be judged more strictly.*

MARK 10:38 = *But Jesus said to them, "You don't know what you are asking! Are you able to drink from the bitter cup of suffering I am about to drink? Are you able to be baptized with the baptism of suffering I must be baptized with?"*

ACTS 12:1-2 = *About that time King Herod Agrippa began to persecute some believers in the church.* ² *He had the apostle James (John's brother) killed with a sword.*

MARK 10:39-45 = *"Oh yes," they replied, "we are able!" Then Jesus told them, "You will indeed drink from my bitter cup and be baptized with my baptism of suffering.* ⁴⁰ *But I have no right to say who will sit on my right or my left. God has prepared those places for the ones he has chosen."* ⁴¹ *When the ten other disciples heard what James and John had asked, they were indignant.* ⁴² *So Jesus called them together and said, "You know that the rulers in this world lord it over their people, and officials flaunt their authority over those under them.* ⁴³ *But among you it will be different. Whoever wants to be a leader among you must be your servant,* ⁴⁴ *and whoever wants to be first among you must be the slave of everyone else.* ⁴⁵ *For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many."*
